

FAQs:

Are masks required?

Our staff wear masks at all times. We are following local, state, and federal guidelines regarding COVID-19 and other transmissible diseases.

In Fall 2021, we are using our outdoor pavilion for service meaning that all of our seating is outdoors (mostly in the shade). We leave it to our guests whether they want to wear masks while on the grounds or not.

Do you have outdoor seating?

All of our seating is currently outside - under canopies, under a pavilion, or you can choose to enjoy our baseball field, dog park, children's area, or sit in the green space. We are renovating the inside space this fall/winter and will open our indoor biergarten in the spring.

Do you serve food?

Outside food is welcome at all times, and Gordonsville has several restaurants with food available for take-out. We intend to host food trucks every Friday evening, Saturday afternoon and Sunday afternoon; check out calendar for times/dates.

Are dogs permitted?

Leashed dogs are welcome in all areas. We have a fenced dog-park if you want to give your dog some off-leash exercise.

What drinks do you serve?

Patch possesses both farm brewery and farm winery licenses, so we have beer, wine and cider on tap. We also have Virginia wine available for purchase by the bottle.

Do you have live music?

We hope to provide live music on Saturday afternoons in Fall 2021. These will be listed on our calendar so you can plan ahead.
